Alison Jones and Milly Thompson were LGP's Autumn Artists-in-Residents, continuing the long-standing discussion and project that erupts every now and again for an altered re-iteration and re-thinking. For this they produced a 'poster', a photomontage which considers gendered labour set against the backdrop of the C21st art world.

The full size colour print was displayed on a Coventry city centre adboard from 25 September – 20 October.

A stack of mass produced A3 riso prints, in navy, was available as a free carry-out from the gallery in association with the exhibition 'Stolen planks from under the bourgeois phalanx'.
