


Eccleston Yards 15:00-16:30 Imago paper for photobooths Susanna Kraus


IMAGO is a direct positive paper now cut for analogue black and white photobooths. Susanna Kraus from Imago will present the paper and show its key benefits: high contrast, fine graduation, and high silver content following the legendary Ilfochrome look. The paper requires a double tank of developer (30 seconds) and three tanks of fixer. The rest of tanks are used as rinse tanks. The paper will be available in 40.5mm width and developer will be supplied by @photoautomatberlin.

Waterstones, Gower Street 17:30-19:00 Photobooth: A Biography Meags Fitzgerald

In this hybrid talk / workshop, author Meags Fitzgerald will read from her 2014 graphic novel, Photobooth: A Biography, which chronicles the machines' history and the present-day community dedicated to preserving them. She'll discuss the process of making the book as well as the process of presently adapting it into a documentary. For twenty years Meags has used photobooths in her art practice, including making stop motion animations using single photobooth pictures as frames. She'll demonstrate how she achieves practical effects by using mirrors, filters, magnifiers, and more.












Noka Tattoo & Netil House 09:00-14:00 Convention Tattoo Hannah Keuls and Chris Hewish

Hackney Bridge 12:00-13:00 Ilford Gallerie paper for photobooths Rafael Hortala-Vallve

Together with Matteo Sani at Fotoautomatica in Florence, Autofoto has been working on making an off-the-shelf paper work for analogue photobooths. We are using standard chemistry (with an extra boost) and are also increasing developer temerature (37 rather than the 32 degrees we used for Slavich). No other changes are needed and the results are very encouraging...

Hackney Bridge 15:00-17:00 Roundtable / Q&A / merch table

Wrapping up the convention we'll have a roundtable with four or five operators and artists. Panel members will share a photobooth related story and we'll have the chance to have an open discussion about the past, present and future of analogue photobooths.

On the side we will have a merch table where attendees will be able to sell / buy zines, stickers, posters and other photobooth paraphernalia.
